The **SIGNIS World Congress** is now in full gear. To be part of the event, we invite children to participate in the first-ever **Global Children's Handkerchief Project**. This Project is open to all **children from 3 to 12 years of age** in your country, irrespective of gender, race, culture or religion. To participate, all they have to do is to make a hand-print (palm & 5 fingers) with any colour paint on a handkerchief.

The Global Children's Handkerchief Project will symbolically represent children from various parts of the world (where SIGNIS is working with children) in the SIGNIS World Congress with the theme: **Media for a Culture of Peace. Children's Rights, Tomorrow's Promise**. The hand-printed handkerchiefs will be displayed during the opening Eucharistic celebration, and will become an exhibit throughout the Congress. Be a part of the historic moment, and enable your country's children to be symbolically 'present' at the Congress.

#### Global Children's Handkerchief Project Guidelines:

- 1 Each country may send in as many hand-printed handkerchiefs as they wish.
- 2 Any regular-size handkerchief of any texture and colour is acceptable.
- 3 Each handkerchief shall contain several hand-prints of children.
- 4 Each handkerchief must have the following information:
  - a. Name of Country
  - b. Any sub-theme or area of concern under the main theme, e.g. "The child's right to education" (refer to [www.unicef.org/crc/](http://www.unicef.org/crc/))
  - c. Date of hand-printing.
- 5 Completed handkerchiefs are to be mailed only to the given address in Thailand by **31st August 2009**.
- 6 Submitted handkerchiefs become the property of SIGNIS Brussels.
